

Lifting a wheelchair in to a car



Plan the move and prepare the environment. Decide how best to move THIS wheelchair in to THIS vehicle. Place a rug/blanket in the boot to protect the car and also to slide the wheelchair more easily if required. Lock or unlock the wheelchair brakes as needed.

- Knees and hips bent,
- Maintain the natural curves of your spine,
- Keep elbows as close to your body as possible,
- Brace your stomach muscles
